



Job Posting: Articling Student – 10 Month Contract

WTCLS has an opening for an articling student for the 2026-2027 articling year. The position starts in August 2026 (specific date to be negotiated) and runs for 10 months.

WTCLS is a busy urban clinic which includes lawyers, a community legal worker, paralegal, social worker, housing help workers, and a rent bank location. The environment is collaborative and team oriented, with a view to building a healthy workplace delivering the most effective supports for our community. As we are a community-based clinic, our staff work on location at our Bloor Street office (near Dufferin subway station).

The articling student will work closely with the clinic's legal staff on files relating to housing, social assistance, and disability. There may also be an opportunity to gain exposure to immigration or workers' rights law depending on the student's interest. The student will gain experience in legal research, drafting, client relations, litigation before administrative tribunals, and the practical aspects of legal practice. The student will also gain experience working with a diverse client population.
